**CDT Middle Fork Trail #157** from Snow Lake to 1 mile below Fly V Canyon. Fixed 7 large blowouts from last year's flood. Also logged and brushed the trail.



**CDT High Route Trail** improvements from Clear Creek to Aeroplane Mesa Trailhead. Trotter Trail #30 and Aeroplane Mesa Trail #705 – spot brushing and logged.

53 logs removed and 12 trail markers.

## #160 Granny Mtn, #159 Miller Springs, #155 Turkey Creek, & #403 Brushy Mtn Trails

**Mileage completed:** 16 miles.

- Logged Granny Mtn Trail from the Junction with # 162 to Miller Springs Cabin
- Logged and spot-brushed the Miller Springs Trail # 159.
- Logged and brushed 2 miles of the Brushy Mtn trail from the junction with # 160.
- Logged the Turkey Creek trail from the junction with Miller Springs Trail # 159 to 2 miles upstream.

**Accomplishments:**

- 165 logs removed (many crosscut logs), 8 trail markers, brushing.



## Big Bear Trail #28 and Lilley Park Trail #164 near Lilley & Woodland Park

- extensive retread

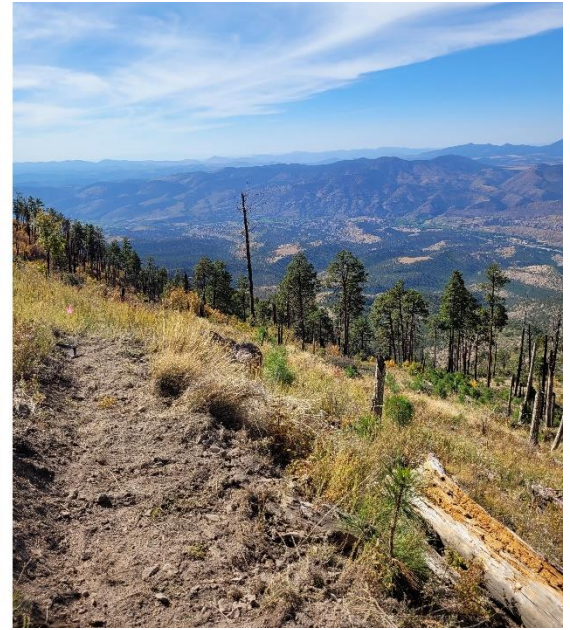


This was a challenging project. Major thanks to:

- The packers who packed up 100 gallons of water so we could dry camp – in addition to food, tools and gear.

- The trail volunteers who backpack up 2200 ft elevation in 3 miles to basecamp and then hiked up another 1700 ft elevation while doing trail work.

- The volunteer cooks who made 110 meals for the project.



**Note:** The last half mile is passable for hikers but still needs additional work to make it nice.
